



Athletic Informed Consent Form

Pointe Schools provides Jr. High and High School students with the opportunity to participate in physical education classes and extra-curricular athletic teams.

These courses and sports require students to be in good physical shape and condition. Students are expected to participate in strenuous activities that demand physical strength and endurance.

While participating in a class activity or extra-curricular sport, the risk of injury is high, and students injuries could result in broken bones, partial or total paralysis, or even death.

Because of the possibility of serious or catastrophic injury or death and the risks involved, students must have a parent or guardian consent to their participation in a physical education class and/or extra-curricular athletic team.

By signing below, students and parents/guardians release Pointe Schools' employees, the Pointe Schools' Executive School Council, and the Governing Board of Pointe Educational Services from any claim of negligence and from any liability arising from claims for damages for injury to our son/daughter and any claims for loss of or damage to his/her property which may arise out of his/her participation in a physical education class and/or extra-curricular athletic team.
